Frequently Asked Questions about our Private Hire Opportunities

Can I bring my own decorations?

We understand that people may wish to bring their own decorations, however, we do not allow any decorations outside of the yurt due to the potential environmental impact that this may have.

One or two balloons can be tied inside the yurt, as can a few decorations, but this will need to be carefully tied to the internal yurt structure with ribbons or string (no tape, pins, blue-tac or other fixings can be used).

Why are numbers limited to 20 children?

Whilst we understand that some people wish to invite their child's whole school class, this can sometimes be up to 32 children. If you then include an adult for each child, this can be up to 64 people on the site at any one time, which exceeds our site guidelines. These guidelines are partly informed by the available space we have for parking (max of 16 cars), as we do not wish to have a negative impact on the surrounding roads by having cars parked up in the lanes. But is also a choice that is guided by our many years of experience of hosting and facilitating groups of children, the space we have in our yurt, and our choice to ensure that our site is respected and cared for.

Where do my guests park?

There is a farm track leading up to The Patch which can accommodate 16 cars, we provide an information sheet for you to send to your guests with details of how to find us.

What happens if it's raining?

We are natural, outdoors site, and unless there are very strong winds, we operate in all weathers. We have covered areas for our activities, and the yurt, with a log burning stove, for shelter. Please ensure that you and your guests come is suitable clothing and footwear for the forecast weather (our information sheet also gives details of what to wear / bring for your guests).
